{PROGRAMMING}

Tranquil Space Foundation (TSF) concluded its TranquilTeens programming and released the final <u>8-week 54-page curriculum</u> at no charge to the public.

TSF's focus shifted to Pigs & Pugs Project to raise awareness, host events, and provide micro grants. The board began planning the first Pigs & Pugs Project event for March 1, 2018 on National Pig Day. In addition, TSF created a new logo, updated the website and social media to reflect the shift toward animal welfare and created a compilation of pig sanctuaries and pug rescues across the United States. {GRANTS}

Since our start in 2006, TSF gave over \$25,000 to organizations aligned with fueling the wave of female empowerment both locally and globally. These micro grants helped women and their families struggling with HIV/AIDS, women artisans in developing countries, homeless women in the DC area, and more. Learn more here.
