{MISSION}

{PROGRAMMING}

Tranquil Space Foundation (TSF) continues to grow Pigs & Pugs Project and raise awareness of pigs and pugs, host events, and provide micro grants to sanctuaries and rescues in need.



The first Pigs & Pugs Project event was a screening of the documentary, *The Last Pig* on National Pig Day, March 1, 2018 with special guests Gene Baur of Farm Sanctuary and Charlotte the potbelly pig.



TSF also held two successful fundraisers, Yoga and the Animals (June) and Pugs and Pints (October). Through these three events, we raised \$3,500 for pig sanctuaries and pug rescues.



In addition, TSF updated its website and social media to reflect the shift toward animal welfare under the Pigs & Pugs Project branding. The board voted to formally change the name of the organization to Pigs & Pugs Project in 2019.

{GRANTS}

In 2018, TSF gave \$6,421 to pig sanctuaries and pug rescues in need. Since the shift to animal welfare programming in 2016, TSF has given \$10,000 in micro grants that have helped organizations dealing with a medical crisis, hoarding cases, natural disasters, and more.
